

Admission of foreign citizens of Romanian origin 2019

International students with Romanian origins are those citizens who do not have a Romanian ID. They may come from: Serbia, Albania, Macedonia, Ukraine, Republic of Moldova, Bulgaria, Croatia, Greece, Israel, Hungary or Diaspora.

According to the Methodology for admission of the international students with Romanian origins at the higher education level for the academic year of **2019-2020**, these citizens participate in the admission's process on special granted places, subsidized by the Romanian state.

The scholarships from the Ministry of National Education from Romania are divided in two categories:

- ▶ **Free of charge tuition fee with monthly scholarship** with financing from the state budget for: tuition fee, monthly scholarship and accommodation in student dormitory;

- ▶ **Free of charge tuition fee without scholarship:** with financing from the state budget for: tuition fee and accommodation in student dormitory.

- ▶ Transport under the same conditions with the Romanian students, according to the current national legislation;

- ▶ Other types of scholarships, in accordance with the current legislation.

A student can benefit for a single domain in the same cycle of studies from the state budget, the second one would be allowed only by paying the tuition fees.

Language of Study

The Ministry of National Education has decided that the beneficiaries of the scholarships should study **only in the Romanian language**.

If the candidate does not know the Romanian language, he/she must attend **Preparatory Year for learning Romanian language**. The students study the Romanian terms specific to the faculty domains where he/she will continue the studies - arts.

Candidates who have not studied at least 4 years in Romanian and do not want to attend the preparatory year will take the Romanian language test and must obtain the Certificate of Romanian language proficiency.

International students with Romanian origins must enter Romania with a STUDY VISA and have the obligation to submit their files to the Bucharest Immigration Service in order to obtain the right to stay legally in Romania for study purposes (RESIDENCE PERMIT).

The first step:

Registration period (e-mail) just only for pre-checking documents:
July 22, 2019 – August 20, 2019

Candidates send their admission documents (only scanned copies) via e-mail:

- Documents for bachelor and master studies: international@unarte.org;
- Documents for PhD: doctorat@unarte.org;

ATTENTION!!!

This first step helps foreign candidates only in terms that the university evaluates the file, but does not exclude enrollment and admission from the periods established in the admissions methodologies.

The file with the original papers will be submitted by the candidate, according to the calendars provided in the admissions methodologies :

FOR THE ADMISSION PROCESS (BACHELOR / MASTER/ PhD) the application file must contain the following documents (certified/authorised translations **ONLY in Romanian language**).

- **An envelope dossier with:**
 - **Application Form** – all requested information filled in entirely in 2 samples (please specify if you want Preparatory Year or not)- downloaded from www.unarte.org
 - **Language proficiency certificate (in original)**, if the applicant doesn't speak Romanian language, he/she should learn Romanian during a preparatory year. Exempted are the candidates coming from states whose official language is the study language of the program they have applied for, and also the candidates who can prove with documents that they have studied for at least 4 years academic programs in the study language of the program they have applied for. - **The studies documents** – legally certified copies and translations of High School Diploma (and of Bachelor Diploma if the candidate applies for Master studies, or the Master Diploma as well for candidates who want to follow a PhD study programme);
- Copy of the diploma supplement or a certificate legally certified copies and translations indicating the school situation for all years of study, as well as the results obtained at the bachelor exam (for graduates of current year), for applicants who request the continuance of master or postgraduate university studies.
- **Academic records** - legally certified copies and translations – for the completed studies (High School and Bachelor) and the analytical curriculum in case of candidates that request equivalence for certain periods of studies;
- For those how graduates the study programs followed abroad, the study papers will be accompanied by the **recognition certificate issued by MENCS-CNRED** (<https://cnred.edu.ro>)
- **Birth certificate** - copy and legally certified translation;
- **Copy of the passport** – valid at least 6 months after the date when the Letter of Acceptance to studies is issued;
- **Medical certificate** (translate in romanian language) to prove that the person to be registered for studies does not suffer from infectious incompatible with the future profession;
- **Marriage license** – if necessary or other document (to prove the name change) copy and legalized translation in Romanian at the notary public;
- **2 recent photos** ¾ cm, color;
- **Copy of the document attesting the residency abroad (if the case)**
- **Declaration on his/her own** responsibility that he does not own and did not hold an identity card and / or passport issued by the Romanian authorities, authenticated by the notary;
- **Self-declaration** by which the candidate undertakes that he / she will not simultaneously benefit from public funding for two university degree programs, regardless of their level, and that he / she will not simultaneously attend more than two university study programs, regardless of level and form financing them (for EU, EEA and EC citizens only);
- **List of published works (only for Phd studies)**
- **Curriculum vitae (only for Phd Studies)**
- **Receipt** issued by the bank (The Romanian Commercial Bank, IBAN account RO06RNCB0072039062550016, mentioning the name, CNP, type of study, study program and type of fee (enrollment), which will result in payment of the registration fee for the admission contest - 150 RON
