	<p>In Romania, most of the state universities' dormitories represent an aid for the students, that is why the accommodation fee is the smallest one. At UNArte dormitory, the fee is about 70 EUR/month and the Erasmus student has to pay for the entire semester in advance during the first week (about 3 months).</p> <p>There are offered basic living conditions. The room is 20 sqm, and it is shared by 3 students/roommates.</p>
